Executive Summary Review – Shared Governance

 - ix. Office of Head Start wants the ESD Board to oversee everything and look deeply at all aspects of the program
 - x. This committee was formed and ESD by-laws were changed so that we are in compliance with what Office of Head Start is requiring
 - xi. We are still trying to figure out how it will look

- iii. Some centers have lots of non-federal share and others (child care centers) don't have as much
