Accountability of the Superintendent

The Superintendent is the Board's only link to the operation of the organization. Other than as required by law, all authority over and accountability of staff is considered to be the responsibility of the Superintendent.

Accordingly:

- 1. The Board will never give directives to persons who report directly or indirectly to the Superintendent.
- 2. The Board will not formally evaluate any staff member other than the Superintendent.
- 3. Other than stating its values through policy, the Board will not participate in decisions or action involving the hiring, evaluating, disciplining or dismissal of any employee other than the Superintendent.
